## Pakistan's Organized Crime Weekly Review

Compiled by National Initiative against Organised Crime (NIOC)

## 09 November to 15 November 2020

The COVID-19 pandemic is not only affecting the economies and societies across the world but also changing the trends of the organized crime and illicit markets. Pakistan is already facing critical economic challenges as well as issues related to governance and internal security. While the coronavirus pandemic has complicated these challenges, it can also bring to fore new challenges related to organized crime and non-state actors in the country. There is a need for institutional vigilance to monitor the changing trends for better understanding and preparedness to cope with future challenges. The National Initiative against Organized Crime (NIOC) is initiating a weekly monitor on Organized Crime as a civil society initiative to support the institutional and community responses. The weekly brief is a result of information collected from open sources, mainly the mainstream media reports, both Urdu and English as well as information collected from various experts associated with the Project.

The nationwide confirmed cases of Covid-19 were 359,032 as of November 15, 2020, while 323,824 of them have recovered so far in the country. The death toll reached 7,160. The detail on regional distribution of the total detected cases across Pakistan as well as consequent deaths is given in the table below:<sup>1</sup>

#### 1. Terrorism Watch

Two terrorist attacks happened in Pakistan during the week under review. In one of these attacks, militants of a Baloch insurgent group threw a hand grenade in a police patrolling van in Quetta on November 13th, which exploded injuring three policemen and two others.<sup>2</sup>

Separately, a tribal elder Malik Abdur Rasheed, 65, was on way to home in his Khoor Chai village when unknown militants opened fire on him. The elder was critically wounded and taken to the district hospital, Khar, but he did not survive.<sup>3</sup>

# 2. Drug Trafficking

President Dr. Arif Alvi, while emphasizing the need for collective efforts to curb the menace of drug addiction in university campuses, directed the Higher Education Commission (HEC) to develop policy guidelines in consultation with all the stakeholders to support universities in this regard.<sup>4</sup>

In countrywide operations, the Anti-Narcotics Force (ANF) seized 148 Kgs narcotics and arrested 19 culprits including three women.<sup>5</sup> In a separate operation, the ANF arrested one drug peddler in Vehari and seized 1000 Kgs of hashish from his possession.<sup>6</sup> The ANF arrested three suspects and seized drugs including 7 Kgs of hashish from them during separate operations in Karachi.<sup>7</sup>

Meanwhile, Pakistan coast guards arrested two drug peddlers and seized 9 Kgs of hashish during an operation in Balochistan.<sup>8</sup> Drugs worth Rs 20 billion including crystal meth were seized by

Pakistan coast guards during another operation in the hilly areas near Pasni.<sup>9</sup> The anti-narcotics court sentenced a drug peddler to two years in prison for smuggling over 2Kgs of hashish to Masqat.<sup>10</sup>

The police in the four provinces also conducted multiple anti-drug operations as mentioned below:

- A special anti-drug police team in Islamabad nabbed a drug peddler from Saidpur and recovered 4 Kgs of hashish and 2Kgs of heroin from his possession. <sup>11</sup> In a separate operation against criminal activities in Rawalpindi, police arrested 14 drug peddlers and seized drugs including over 8 Kgs of hashish from them. <sup>12</sup>
- Loralai police arrested two drug peddlers and seized 15 Kgs of hashish from their possession. 13
- Chiniot police arrested a drug peddler. He was arrested for drug peddling for the 20th time in 23 years. However, the district bar secretary Irfan Nekokara urged reforms in criminal justice system of Pakistan.<sup>14</sup>
- Kasur police arrested two drug peddlers including a women and seized over 3 Kgs of hashish from them.<sup>15</sup>
- Sialkot police arrested a drug peddler and seized over 7 Kgs of hashish, 3 Kgs of heroin from his possession. 16
- The University of Engineering and Technology, Lahore has decided to form an anti-drug force to curb the menace of drug trafficking in its premises.<sup>17</sup>
- Hub police arrested a drug peddler and seized 8 Kgs of crystal from his possession. Shalkot police during a raid in Quetta recovered 160 Kgs of hashish from an Afghan smuggler. In a separate operation, Quetta police arrested one drug peddler and seized 160 Kgs of hashish from his possession. In Manager 20 Kgs of hashish from his possession.

- Sahiwal police arrested two drug peddlers and seized over 2 Kgs of hashish from them.<sup>21</sup>
- Peshawar police arrested one drug peddler and seized over 4 Kgs of heroin from his possession.<sup>22</sup>
- Karachi police arrested two suspects of drug trafficking and seized drugs including hashish, heroin and ice from their possession.<sup>23</sup>
